## What is a declension?

A declension is a **group** that a noun belongs to.

We have already met the 1st declension:

puella = girl (feminine)

	<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
Nominative	puella <b>a</b>	puell <b>ae</b>
Accusative	puell <b>am</b>	puell <b>ās</b>

All **1st declension nouns** follow this pattern.
